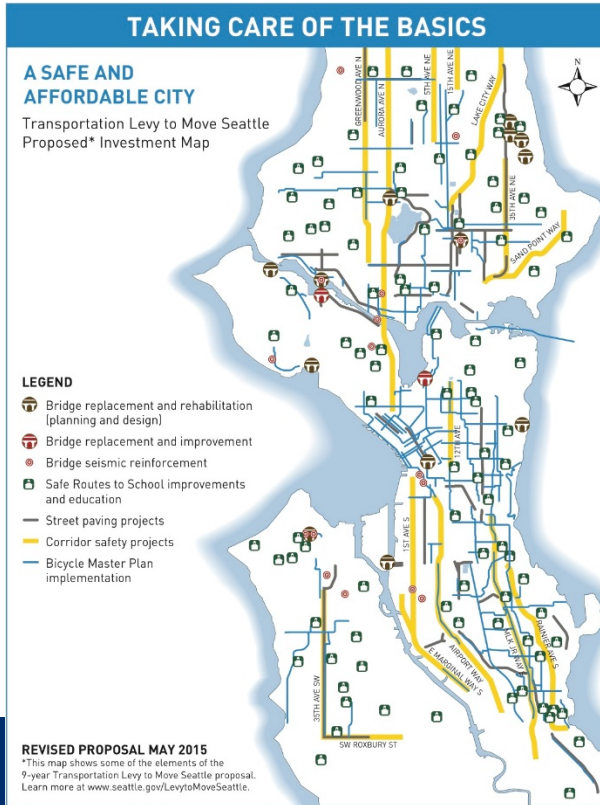

Future Lines

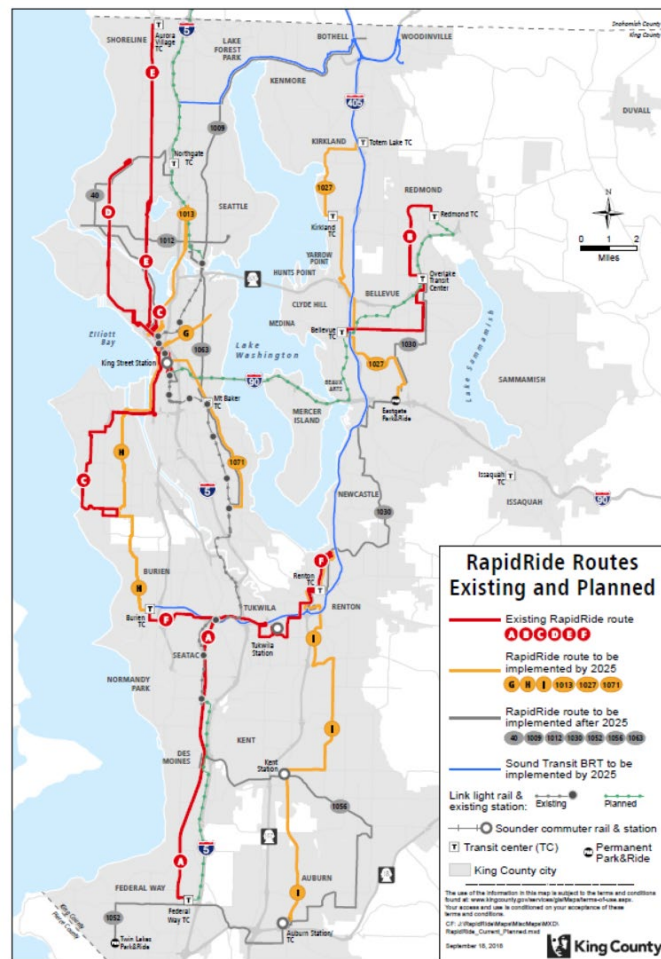
- Orange (2024) & Red (2027)

Growing to 12 lines by 2025

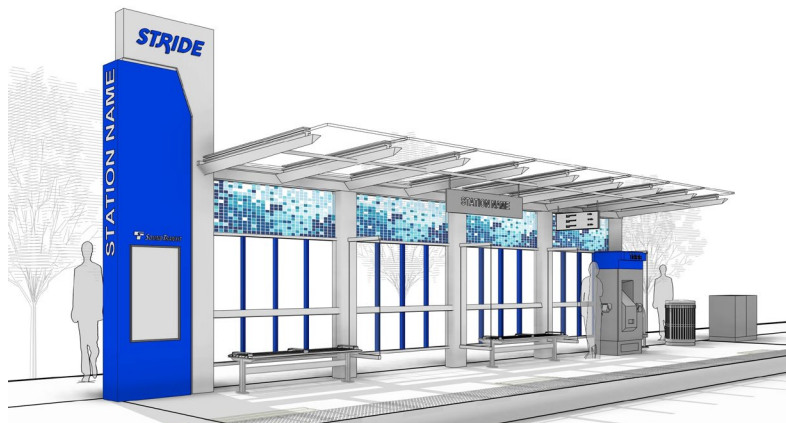
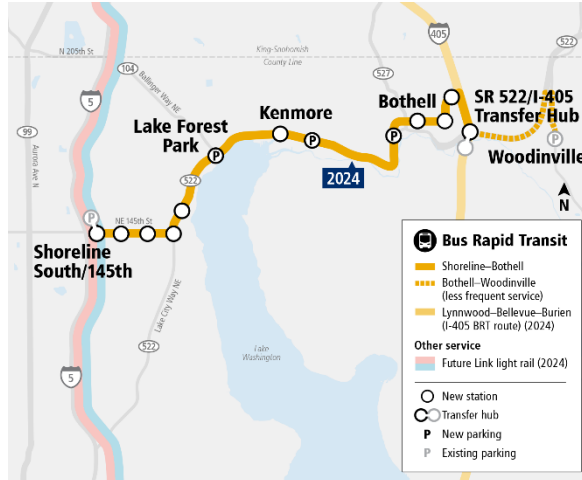


Sound Transit **STRIDE**

2 corridors, 3 routes

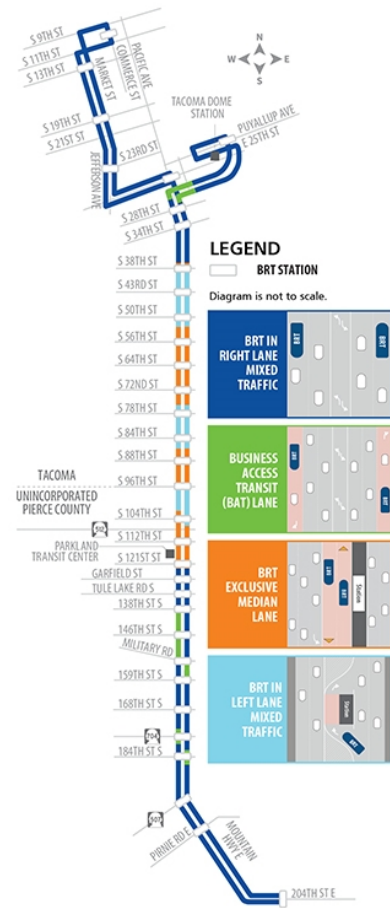
- SR 522 Arterial BRT

- Replaces existing Route 1



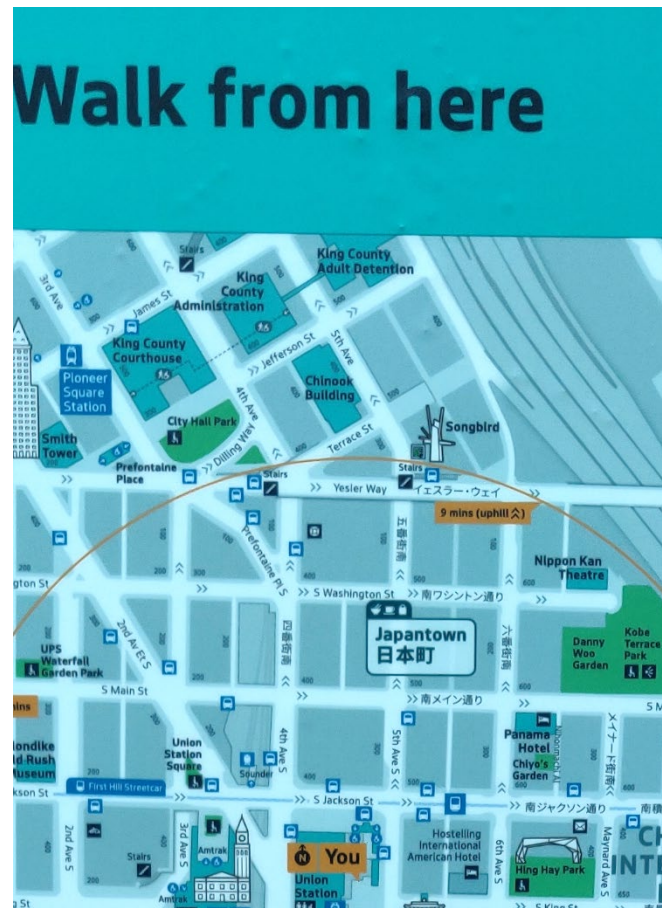
Ongoing Challenges
